**Orange Unified School District, Title VII-Native American Education Program**

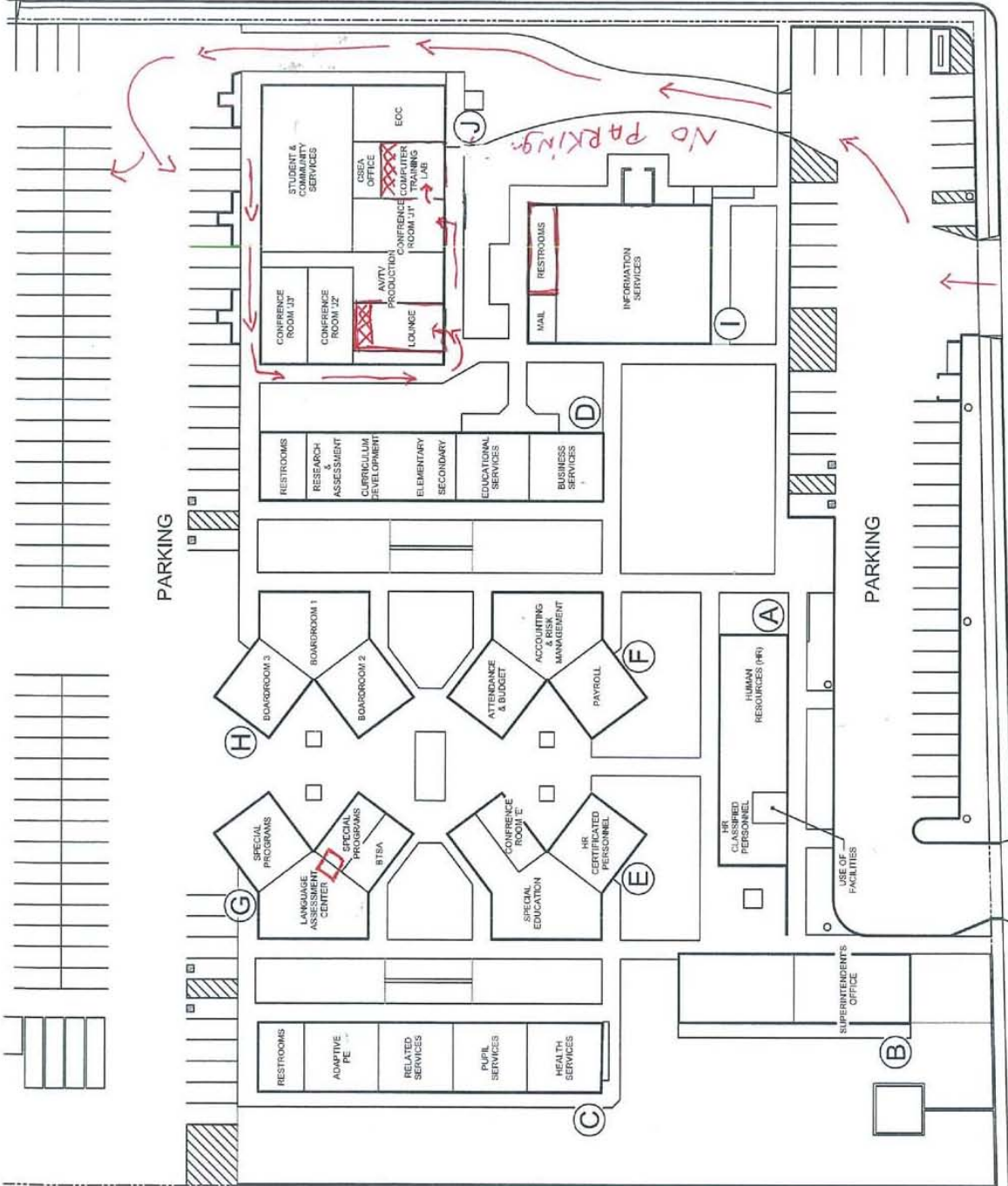
