GAME HISTORY-LOCAL ELDERS RECALL THE WAW'KISH (SHINNY/STICKBALL) GAME BEING PLAYED AMONG THE MISSION INDIANS OF SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA IN THE LATE 1800'S. IT IS PLAYED BY TWO TEAMS WHO HIT A SMALL WOODEN BALL, ABOUT TWO INCHES IN DIAMETER, WITH LONG STICKS CURVED AT ONE END. POINTS ARE SCORED WHEN THE BALL IS SUCCESSFULLY HIT BEYOND THE GOAL LINES DRAWN AT EACH END OF THE PLAYING FIELD. THE GAME CAN BECOME ROUGH AS THE MEN WRESTLE TO GAIN CONTROL OF THE BALL.
