Background

Central High/Tri C (Community Centered Classrooms) is an urban, continuous enrollment, alternative education school. Students receive individualized graduation plans, college counseling, and encouragement to explore career and technical education training in a smaller class environment.



Central High/Tri-C is comprised of twenty-seven sites located in communities throughout the LAUSD. The classrooms are located on school campuses, a senior center, commercial office space, a bank building, community centers, and occupational centers. CHS - UAII Branch is a partnership between LAUSD and UAII's American Indian Clubhouse.
